Lloyd presentation to Brian Robinson in recognition of his restoration of 64 Meteor.



It is a 1964 Mercury Meteor "Breezeway" so named because of the electric back window which created a breezeway effect inside.

It has the optional 352 cu. in. engine paired with a 3 speed A.T. Power steering and power brakes.

The car was sold new at Maccam Motors in Moose Jaw to the then Fire Chief of Moose Jaw

After his passing, I purchased the car from his son who is also a retired Fire Chief. The restoration was completed in the spring of 2017.

Ford in the U.S. had dropped the Meteor from there lineup at the end of '63. Ford of Canada quickly reintroduced it as a stand alone model.

So, Meteor re-emerged at the beginning of the 1964 model year, very different from the earlier Ford -based Meteors, and the mid sized 1962-63 Mercury Meteors built in the U.S.
