The new executive was introduced: Al Willms Pres; Ron Just V/P; Lloyd Minion Past Pres; Bob Schmidt Secretary; Dave Brock Treasurer; Jerry Lupul and Tim Roden 1yr directors; Don Pidlisny, Verne Morelli 2 yr directors. Old Business:

- Derby Car, On January 25th Bob Mcquire, Norm Mowles, and Al Willms travelled to Moose Jaw WDM to meet with Steve Van Vlaenderen, Darlene Hildebrand, author and publisher of Vanishing Wheels; and Dave Burva President of the Road Rebels Car Club, Brandon Manitoba regarding the Derby Car that was restored in 2013 -2014 by the SAAC.
 - -Bob was the lead organizer of the 30 some SAAC volunteers

- -Norm was the President at the time and was approached by WDM to see if SAAC would take on this project.
- -Steve had already been doing research on the Derby and Davis car companies and wanted to get some pictures of the Derby that is presently residing at WDM Moose Jaw
- -Local newspaper reporters were in attendance to interview Bob, Steve and Darlene, the article can be read by clicking on the attached link; https://www.moosejawtoday.com/local-news/rare-1920s-derby-car-at-wdm-captures-attention-of-winnipeg-authorphotographer-8170426
- -Darlene's part of the interview was quite fascinating to listen to as it dealt with the economic tides of the 1920's and how the Davis and Derby companies came to be, and also how they inevitably failed.
- -A number of club members made significant investment in the Derby car, and wish it returned to Saskatoon.
- -Note: The car is owned by the Saskatchewan WDMs.
- -There is still some concern about a fund worth \$5,000.00 to help with the restoration costs at the time. Lloyd Minion spoke to the issue of the \$5000 surplus. The monies have been used by the WDM in their current restoration of a 1928 Mode A Roadster.
