Greetings from Melfort & District Museum. I am a volunteer here and past Board Chair. I was talking to my friend Wilf Stringer of Martinsville a few months ago about our Ford Model TT truck. His recent death leaves me a bit uncertain where to turn for assistance/advice. The truck is partially rebuilt. The previous owner's father did the motor in the 1970'a, and our carpenter has repaired the cab roof recently and is working on the seat. We originally rescued it partly under snow several years ago, so may have missed a part or two, but believe most parts are with it. We have recently realized, however, that the rear wheels are missing, and we've been unable to find a set. I'm not sure what the size is, but the guys who work in the shop tell me they were larger than the ones we have. We do not have anyone with experience in restoring vehicles, so are wondering if you have anyone who might be willing to take a run this way and look the truck and parts over? I know there would be a cost. Wilf was going to do it but of course now that won't happen. I believe he had a friend with experience but am not sure if he is involved in your club. I will have to get his name, which I cannot recall. Any suggestions you have would be appreciated. It is taking up a fair bit of space in our (heated) shop, but since its a rather rare item we hate to put it outside in the elements.

I go through Saskatoon often as I have a family farm west of Biggar and would be happy to stop there to discuss this if you think you have any resources to offer. I have no experience in this field myself but do some researching for the museum. And I was part of the original acquisition, but we didn't know at the time it was a TT and so a bit more unusual.

7. New Business:

- Change to Club Bylaws in regard to extending Executive Positions by an additional year. Mike van Grondelle thanked Fred Remillard for his past and present efforts to update and maintain the club's constitution. The executive wishes to make the following amendments.

14. AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION

This document may only be revised after notice has been given at a regular meeting (It was stated at the AGM), and proposed changes have been distributed to all members at least fourteen days in advance. Amendments must be passed by a two-thirds ballot vote of those present at a regular meeting.

The change in the bylaws was necessitated by the fact that we could not fill the Secretary Position at the AGM with a nomination or a volunteer and the person holding the position (Bob Schmidt) had finished his bylaw mandated term (3 years maximum). Bob said he would be willing to do an additional year (Which we are thankful for) but require this addition to the bylaws to make it possible. The addition to the bylaw is as follows -

“Should an Executive position not be filled by way of nomination or volunteering during the election procedure at the AGM, a position may be filled for a period of only 1 additional year with approval of the members at the AGM and the willingness of the position holder.”

If passed by the members, it would be inserted in the Bylaws under section 10. Directors and Officers, Subsection e.

A retiring director or officer shall be eligible for re-election up to and including the following maximum terms. **Insert Here** (No additional terms may be served in a current position past what the by-laws state.)

1. President, Vice President – one additional one-year term (2 years maximum)
2. Secretary – two additional one-year terms (3 years maximum)
3. Treasurer – three additional one-year terms (4 years Maximum)
4. Past president – one additional one-year term (2 years maximum)
5. Directors – one additional two-year term (4 years maximum)

Motion to amend the constitution. Fred Remillard

Seconded Michael Van Grondelle

Motion: Carried.

Vote: Majority voted in favour.
