Al Willms summary of the Derby Car Relocation to Saskatoon

A few weeks prior to the Derby Car arriving in Saskatoon, Lloyd Minion, Ron Just, and Al Willms met with Diana Savage (Director of Exhibits WDM) to pitch the idea of having the Derby Car brought back to Saskatoon as its rightful location. Diana and other executives at the WDM were very receptive of the idea and agreed it is time the Derby came home to Saskatoon as that was the city where the Derby factory was located in the 1920's.

The problem is, WDM was in need of some assistance to transport the car here, they no longer had their own carrier equipment for a long distance move. Diana reached out to our team, and we were very ready to help and to suggest a safe manner in which to transport this magnificent artifact. As a condition, Lloyd, Ron and Al registered as volunteers for the WDM, which provided us that WDM would insure us against any possible bodily injury under their policy. A 23' enclosed trailer was rented from Flaman and we arranged a date with WDM to move the car (June 13th, 2024). We arrived mid morning at WDM in Moose Jaw, the Derby was waiting at the rear loading area of the building. With the assistance of a couple of the Moose Jaw WDM staff we used an electric winch to pull the Derby into the trailer with Lloyd Minion at the wheel. The car was secured with wheel chocks and straps inside the trailer. After a quick lunch, the Derby Move Team was on their way to Saskatoon.

During the trip to Saskatoon Diana texted and said we will need to temporarily unload the car at the Curatorial Centre due to too much mud behind the Museum. The car was unloaded late afternoon and the trailer returned to Flaman. A few days later the yard dried up enough and the Derby was moved by a local towing company with a deck truck across and up the street to the Museum. So for a brief few minutes the Derby was able see the light of day!

Special thanks to Diana Savage and WDM staff that assisted us to make this all possible, this was an excellent example of how SAAC and WDM were able to work collaboratively to take on this task. Everything was well communicated and went very smoothly for both parties.

Just so our members are aware, the whole move cost SAAC zero dollars. WDM picked up that tab for the trailer rental, mileage, additional vehicle insurance and any other incidentals associated with the move. All that we supplied, was a bit of time from three club members.

This was one example of how a very positive working relationship can benefit both SAAC and WDM. Hoping to see many more opportunities where we can help each other in the future!
