

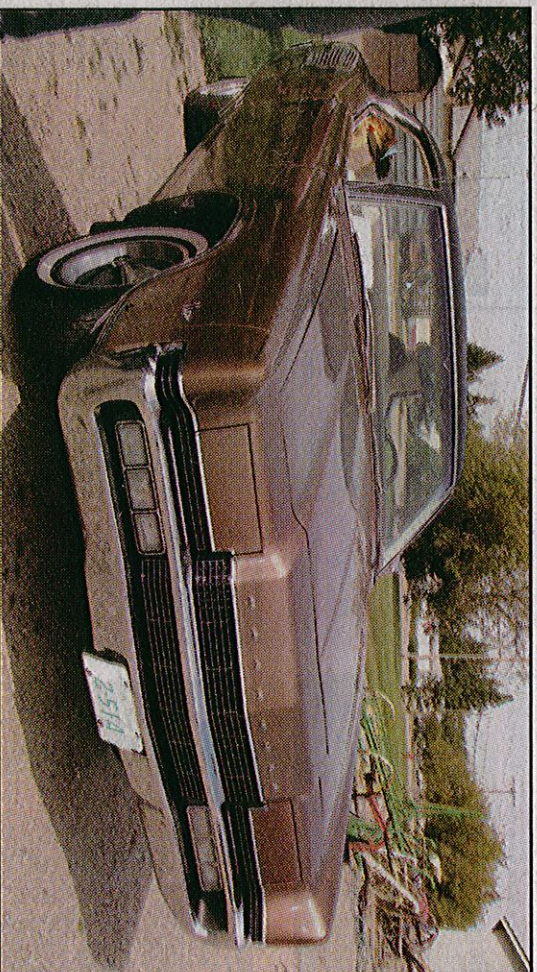
Antique Cars in Wakaw

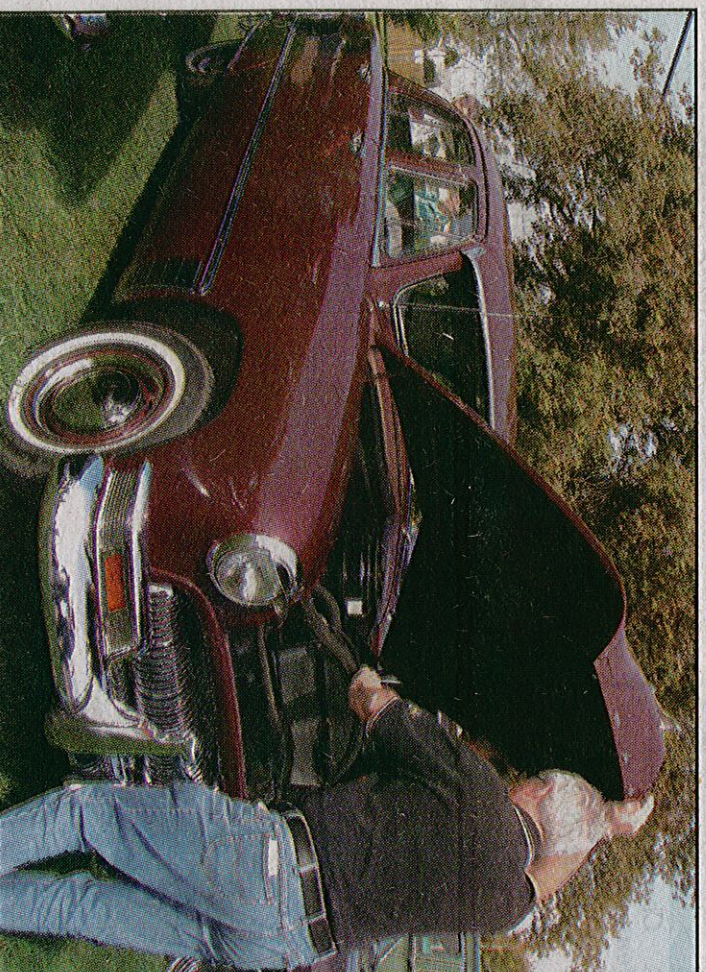

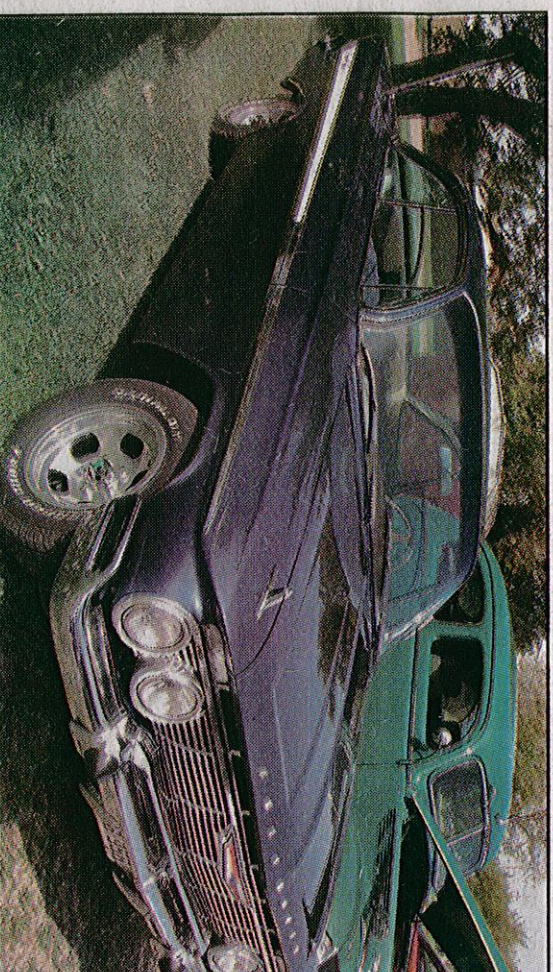
The group who brought their vintage vehicles.

Maroon 1950 Meteor.



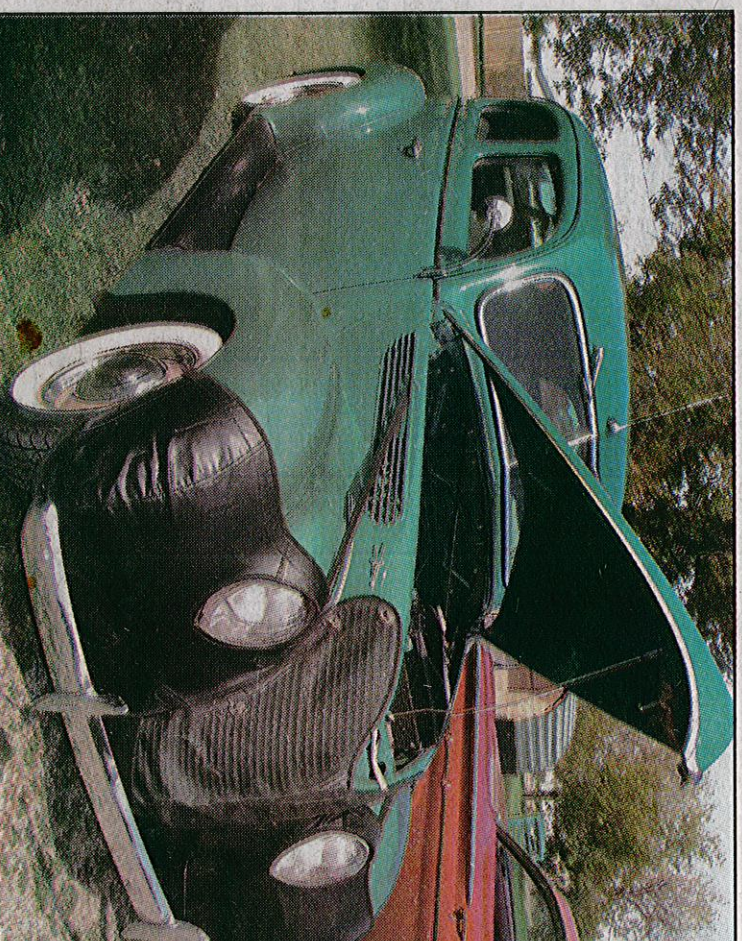
Navy 1961 Chevrolet.
